# Christmas in China Teams

**This Christmas could be unlike any other.**

Spend it in China and experience the joy of sharing Christ with those who have never heard.

## Assignment options:

1. An unreached people group in remote western China desperately needs to hear about the meaning of Christmas. Through teaching English, taking part in a special Christmas program and making friends, you can tell others about the Light of the world. *(6 students needed: 3 male, 3 female)*
2. Join in the excitement of sharing Christmas through storytelling, parties and English conversation with those who have never heard of Christ. Build relationships with students on campuses in this southeastern China city. Prayerwalk and backpack to new unreached areas. *(3-5 teams of 4-6 students needed)*
3. Many spiritually open Chinese are waiting to hear the Truth! Spend your holiday in one of the largest provinces in China sharing with those who have never heard of Christ. Prayerwalk through the city and build relationships along the way. *(6 students needed: 4 male, 2 female)*
4. Share the gospel with an unreached people group in this central China city using dramas, skits, English corners and sports. Literature distribution, prayerwalking and city mapping will help make the Good News available. *(5-15 students needed)*
5. Build relationships with college students in southwest China who have never heard the true meaning of Christmas as you participate in Christmas parties and English corners. *(6 students needed: 3 female and 3 male)*
6. Show the Light of the World to this city of 1.4 million who have never heard the truth about Christmas. Visit local schools, colleges and kindergartens (both rural and urban) to share the Christmas story through song and drama. Learn about Chinese people and culture, making this an unforgettable Christmas! *(5-7 students needed)*
7. Share the true meaning of Christmas in this city of 2.4 million people that hosts 10 unreached people groups. Build relationships with students through personal interaction and skits/drama at several university campuses. *(10 students needed)*
8. Make an eternal difference in the lives of this unreached people group in southwestern China by backpacking through previously unreached villages, spreading the good news of Christmas and building relationships along the way. *(2-4 students needed)*
9. Reveal the truth of Christmas to college students who have little to no understanding of the true meaning of Christmas. Opportunities include drama, skits, teaching English, one-on-one conversations, and prayerwalking. *(4-7 students needed)*
10. Make friends with Chinese students as you hang out together during Christmas parties and English corners. Share the true meaning of Christmas with English-speaking Chinese as you converse in an informal setting. *(4-6 students needed)*
11. Be one of the first to touch the hearts of people in an unreached city. Through prayerwalking and student work, share the message of Christ with many who have never heard. You will open doors for long-term workers. *(4-6 students needed)*
12. There are unlimited opportunities to share the love of Christ this season. Many Chinese people have an understanding of the tradition of gift-giving at Christmas, yet have no understanding of the true reason for celebration. Share the true eternal gift of Christmas. *(10 students needed)*
13. People in this southwestern China city are longing to know more about Christmas celebrations in America. Share the love of Christ during this season include caroling, baking and distributing Christmas cookies, and providing special children's activities. *(6-10 students needed)*
14. Spend your Christmas in a China megacity. Teach English, host Christmas parties, go caroling, and build relationships with Chinese college students who have not yet heard about Jesus. *(4-6 students needed)*
15. Visit northeast China this Christmas to share Christ's love as you build relationships in an English-language setting and share the gospel through Christmas performances. *(6 students needed)*
16. Share the true meaning of Christmas as you build relationships with members of an unreached ethnic-minority group in a remote area of China. *(6-8 students needed)*
17. Tell the Christmas story on a college campus in southern China through English teaching, drama, and a Christmas party. Share Jesus with students who have not yet heard the good news. *(3 teams of 4-6 students needed)*
