Week four

Record how Jesus' life, death, resurrection and ascension relate to the glory of God. John 13:31-32; 17:4; John 12:27-28; Romans 6:4; Philippians 2:9-11.

I have already stated that we live to glorify God. Notice some of the different ways that followers of Jesus Christ are called to glorify God. I Corinthians 6:19-20, 10:31; I Peter 4:11,16.

Notice the prophetic declarations revealing God's global objective. Psalm 72:19; 86:9; Habakkuk 2:14.

God's passion for His name and His glory is the supreme reason for His actions in the world. This does not lessen the fact that He loves us; in fact, it strengthens the concept of His love for us. This Bible study is built on this foundation truth. God's passion for His name should be our central motivation for world evangelization.
